Abstract:

The theme is focused on the relationship between justice and the rule of law, in the context of the recognized doctrines on the rule of law. Always looking for a way to restrict the power and action scope of the state in favor of individual liberty and, implicitly, of the carrying out of the law, in material sense, the rule of law is intended to and must be seen beyond the purely theoretical level. It was always intended to be the mechanism through which the supremacy of the law in relation to the governance would be guaranteed.

The reason behind the analysis stems from the undeniable present interest of the issue of rule of law and from the conviction that this interest is generated by the need to search for the concrete means to translate the concept into reality. And because the history of this concept showed that the postulate cannot guarantee effectiveness, diminishing the risk of inefficiency is only possible through a necessary exercise: returning to the fundamental sense that was once envisioned.
